We members of Provincial Assembly are tabling the motion that under Rule No.181 of Rules of Procedure and conduct of Business, 1974 and under Rule No.115 of Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business 1974 of Assembly and under Article 144 of Constitution of Pakistan 1973, permit us that we table Joint Constitutional Resolution.

ii. Joint Resolution No. 20 by A.Rahim Ziarat wal, Nawab Ayaz Khan, Sardar Mustafa Khan Tareen, Provincial Ministers, Ubaidullah Jan Babat Advisor to CM and William Barkat member Assembly.

This house calls upon the provincial government to contact federal government that Sibi Harnai and Bostan railway line completed in 1886, was profitable till

2006. But in February 2006 few bridges were damaged by terrorists during the period when Harnai was a thesil of sibi district and Harnai could not be linked to Sibi through road, due to which people of Harnai have to travel 210 miles to go to Sibi, whereas same is the situation to travel to divisional headquarter.

District Harnai has the biggest coal deposit of the province but due to non availability of road mine owners cannot afford huge transportation cost. Until the closure of Sibi Harnai railway line it was giving a profit of, according to one estimate, 150 – 200 million rupees annually and the damages of railway lines were paid from this earning. Federal government and railway department in particular is responsible for the provision of funds to repair and construct the most profitable railway section of the province and give relief to the people.

Whereas it is a fact that Quetta Chaman road is an important road of the province, however for the last eight to ten years work on this road has been stopped which is regrettable. It takes three to four hours to travel and the main cause of road accidents and loss of precious lives is the worsening condition of the road. Moreover at the Khojak top 24 to 48 hours traffic jam has become a routine matter and weather condition of -10 C to -15C is unbearable for the general public traveling on the road. It is known fact that FWO and USAID have provided funds for the road but NHA locally responsible people are creating obstacles.

So this house calls upon the provincial government to contact federal government to remove the obstacles and complete the road as soon as possible.
