i) **JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 26 BY MIR IZHAR HUSSAIN KHOSO, MIR ABDUL MAJID ABRO, HAJI MUHAMMAD KHAN LEHRI, MIR TARIQ MAGSI, MIR ASIM KURD GAILOO AND MOHTARMA RAHAT BIBI JAMALI.**

Whereas, Naseerabad is the second largest division of Balochistan province, after Quetta, which is comprised on thickly populated districts like Dera Murad Jamali, Jhal Magsi, Osta Muhammad, Dera Allahyar, Gandwah, Jafferabad, Bolan and Sohbatpur. These districts of Naseerabad division are remote but contrary to this fact hundreds of medical students from these areas appear annually but due to limited seats in Bolan Medical College and inavailability of basic needs they remain deprived of admissions in different medical departments. Keeping in view the ground realities this house therefore calls upon the provincial government that beside approval of proposed medical colleges at Turbat and Loralai areas immediate steps may also be taken to establish medical college in Naseerabad division.

ii) **JOINT RESOLUTION NO 27 BY SARDAR MUHAMMAD ASLAM BIZENJO, REHMAT SALEH BALOCH , MIR KHALID LANGOVE,SHEIKH JAFFER KHAN MANDOKHEL, HAJI MUHAMMAD SALAM BALOCH,MIR HAMAL KALIMATI, MIR MUHAMMAD ASIM GAILOO AND MOHTARMA YASMEEN LEHRI.**

Whereas, the federal government is collaborating Balochistan province in different projects under PSDP. We see Federal government's support with great respect, however at NEC meeting in 2013-14 a 25 percent cut was made to Balochistan especially its water sector projects, while allocating only a 50 percent of demand in the budget. Now when 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter is near to end the allocated funds for 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter have not been released as yet. It is learnt that the federal government is going to make another cut on already 50 percent of meager allocations in the name of PSDP review, which will affect work on 100 dams in water sector projects and Shadikor dam as well. Moreover work on road sector projects including over head bridges of Koila Phattak and Saryab road is already in slow process, even work on some sites is near to get closed.

This house therefore calls upon the provincial government to contact the federal government that no cut should be made in the allocated funds of Federal PSDP 2013-14 and the said funds may be released at the earliest possible. Supplementary grant may also be provided on those water projects which are 70 percent completed and funds in PSDP 2014-15 may also be allocated as per demand of Balochistan province so as all ongoing works could be completed within the stipulated period.

iii) **JOINT RESOLUTION BY THE WOME MPAs FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF WOMEN CAUCUS AT BALOCHISTAN PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY.**

This is a known fact that no nation can make progress until its women folk are provided with equal political, socio-economic opportunities. This house therefore unanimously expresses its resolve that for the welfare and wellbeing of womenfolk of Balochistan province a Women Parliamentary Caucus may be established in Balochistan provincial assembly which could play a pro-active role to accomplish this important mission.
