3. **GOVERNMENT BUSINESS.**

I. JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 33 BY REHMAT SALEH BALOCH, MI. KHALI D LANGOVE AND Dr. SHAMA ISHAQ.

Whereas, the newly appointed doctors by public service commission may be posted in their native areas/districts and this should be mandatory for all the doctors to serve in their respective districts for a period of three years. Balochistan province is in dire need to improve its healthcare facilities and due to shortage of doctors hospitals in all rural areas and district headquarters are in crises. Keeping in view this situation it is necessary to make all those doctors who qualify their post graduate examination should be made bound to serve in their respective district for a term of five years. This house therefore calls upon the provincial government to carry out legislation for this purpose and take immediate steps for its early implementation, so as healthcare facilities could be provided to the people at their doorstep.

II. **JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 34 BY Dr HAMID KHAN ACHAKZAI, NAWAB MUHAMMAD KHAN SHAHWANI, GHULAM DASTAGEER BADINI, MIR AMANULLAH NOTEZAI, ABDUL MAJEED KHAN ACHAKZAI, AMNZOOR AHMED KHAN KAKAR AND NASRULLA ZERAY.**

Whereas, it is a good thing that people on Lahore to Wahga border in Punjab and Tahrparker border in Sindh province are allowed to freely move and there is no restriction or checking on trade and transportation of general items on these borders but contrary to that, in Balochistan which is the largest province of the country area wise and is a backward province regular government taxes are collected on its Chaman and Taftan borders against transportation and trade of general items and after that these have to pass through different check posts set up in different areas of the province particularly in the provincial capital, where Custom, FC, FIA and Police are fleecing people in the name of taxes, creating great problems for them.

This house therefore calls upon the provincial government that like borders of Punjab and Sindh provinces self made check posts at Chaman and Taftan borders may be removed so as people could take a sigh of relief.

III. **JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 35 BY IZHAR HUSSAIN KHOSO, MIR ASIM KURD GAILOO AND MOHTARMA RAHAT BIBI JAMALI.**

Whereas, like other airports of the country Quetta airport also enjoys the status of an international airport but despite this Quetta airport is deprived of all those facilities necessary for an international airport and it has only become an emergency landing place which does not suit to a civilized country.

This house therefore calls upon the provincial government to contact the federal government that on the pattern of Benair Bhutto International airport Islamabad, Allama Iqbal International airport Lahore and Quaid I Azam International airport Karachi, Quetta airport may also be provided with modern facilities and steps be taken for its renovation and beautification.
