3. **GOVT BUSINESS FOR LEGISLATION.**

Tabling of Balochistan QUR'AN MAJEED (Printing and recording) BILL 2015 (BILL NO 2 OF 2015).

I. Advisor to Chief Minister Balochistan for religious affairs and interfaith harmony will present BALOCHISTAN QUR'AN MAJEED (PRINTING AND RECORDING) BILL 2015 (BILL NO 2 OF 2015).

II. Advisor to Chief Minister Balochistan for Religious Affairs and Interfaith Harmony will move that BALOCHISTAN QUR'AN MAJEED (PRINTING AND RECORDING) BILL 2015 (BILL NO 2 OF 2015) may be exempted from rule 84 of Assembly Rules of Procedure and conduct of business 1974.

4. Joint Resolution No. 41. Sheikh Jaffer Khan Mandokhail Minister, Haji Akbar Askani Advisor to Chief Minister Dr. Ruqayya Saeed member Balochistan Provincial Assembly.

Whereas, PIA flights from Quetta to Islamabad via Zhob, Dera Ismail Khan and Peshawar had great importance but now the number of these flights have been minimized from three to only one day which is creating problems for the people. This House therefore calls upon the provincial government to contact the Federal government that the previous schedule of PIA flights may be restored so as sufferings of the people could come to an end.
