I. RESOLUTION NO. 45 BY ENGINEER ZAMRAK KHAN ACHAKZAI, MEMBER PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY.

This House calls upon the provincial government to contact the Federal govt. that for the installation of LPG Gas Plant survey at District Killa Abdullah, Tehsil Chaman City and Khanozai City may be completed immediately and the plant may be installed.

II. RESOLUTION NO. 51 BY WILLIAM BARKAT, MEMBER PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY.

Whereas, Constitution of Pakistan does restrict minorities to seek employment in any department, even 5 percent quota has been allocated for them in government jobs. However, this is not being implemented properly, which is creating sense of deprivation among the youth of the minority. This House therefore calls upon the provincial government to strictly implement 5 percent quota of jobs for minorities in government departments during new appointments and the head of the department should also be answerable to this. Moreover, steps may also be taken to allocate 5 percent quota for minorities in all technical educational institutions.

III. RESOLUTION NO. 58 BY HAJI GUL MUHAMMAD DUMAR, MEMBER PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY.

Whereas, the population of Tehsil Sanjavi of district Ziarat is approximately five lac but the area is still deprived of a Girls Inter College due to which most of the girls students remain deprived to acquire further education after passing their Matric exam. The basic reason of this is tribal norms and culture and poverty as most of the parents do not allow their daughters to reside in hostels. This situation has created sense of deprivation among the students. This House therefore calls upon the provincial government a Girls Inter College may be established in Sanjavi so as sense of deprivation among the students of the area could come to an end.

IV. RESOLUTION NO. 59 BY MOHTARMA SAMEENA KHAN, MEMBER PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY.

Whereas, There is a dangerous curve near a "Mazaar" at Samungli road and in absence of a proper slope most of the vehicles plying from Samungli to Jinnah town go out of control and fall into the City Nullah, causing loss of precious lives and property. This House therefore calls upon the provincial government to ask the concerned department to take steps in this regard and ensure safe flow of traffic on this road.

V. RESOLUTION NO. 60 BY MOHTARMA HUSSN BANO, MEMBER PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY.

Whereas, there is a rapid increase in the population of the provincial capital while in the center and suburban areas of the city housing schemes, flats and plazas are being constructed in violation of Building code and NCO from Municipal Cooperation and these buildings also lack parking areas and toilet facilities which has made life of the people miserable. This House therefore calls upon the provincial government that as Quetta is situated in earthquake Zone therefore action may be taken against the constructions being carried out without NOC and in

violation of Building Code, while action should also be taken against the authorities of the concerned department responsible to this.
