ACT**

further to amend the Baluchistan National Calamities (Prevention and Relief) Act, 1958 (W.P. Act No. XXXIII of 1958).

Preamble.

WHEREAS It is expedient further to amend the Baluchistan National Calamities (Prevention and Relief) Act, 1958, in the manner hereinafter appearing.

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

Short title and commencement.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Baluchistan National Calamities (Prevention and Relief) (Amendment) Act, 1985.

(2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on the 1st day of October, 1984.

Amendment of section 8 of W.P.Act XXXIII of 1958.

2. In the Baluchistan National Calamities (Prevention and Relief) Act, 1958, after sub-section (1) of section 8, the full stop appearing at the end shall be substituted by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added, namely :—

“Provided that no order under this section shall be passed unless the person to be affected thereby is given an opportunity of being heard.”

Saving.

3. Any order passed, action taken or any decision made after the lapse of the Baluchistan National Calamities (Prevention and Relief) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1985 (XVII of 1985), under the provisions of the said Ordinance shall be deemed to have been validly passed, taken, or made, as if this Act was in force on the day on which such order was passed, action taken or decision made.
