No. Legis-X (3)/75. The Provincial Assembly of Baluchistan Privileges (Amendment) Bill, 1975 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Baluchistan on 4th April, 1975 and assented to by the Governor of Baluchistan, is hereby published as an Act of the Provincial Assembly.

THE PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY OF BALUCHISTAN PRIVILEGES (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1975

BALUCHISTAN ACT NO. I OF 1975

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of Baluchistan in the Baluchistan Gazette (Extra-ordinary) dated 11th April, 1975.)

AN

ACT

to amend the Provincial Assembly of Baluchistan Privileges Act, 1973.

Preamble.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Provincial Assembly of Baluchistan Privileges Act, 1973, in the manner hereinafter mentioned:

It is hereby enacted as follows:--

Short title and commencement.

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Provincial Assembly of Baluchistan Privileges (Amendment) Act, 1975.
  - (2) It shall come into force at once.

Addition of Section 10-A in Baluchistan Act No. VII of 1973.

2. In the Provincial Assembly of Baluchistan Privileges Act, 1973 (Baluchistan Act No. VII of 1973) after section 10, the following new section shall be added, namely:—

## "10-A Prohibition to carry arms in the Assembly.

- (1) Whoever carries any fire-arms of any description or knives, lathies, sticks, any explosive or corrosive substance and any weapon of offence, within the precincts of the Assembly shall be liable to punishment with imprisonment of either description, which may extend to six months or with fine which may extend to one thousand rupees or with both.
- (2) The Speaker may direct the Sergeant-at Arms to take appropriate measures, on discovery of any such material as described in sub-section (1) above, within the precincts of the Assembly as defined in clause (pp) of sub-rule (1) of Rule 2 of the Provincial Assembly of Baluchistan Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business, 1974.".
