i. **Joint Resolution No. 15 by Rahim Ziaratwal, Nawab Mohammad Ayaz Khan Jogezeai Provincial Ministers, Obaidlullah Jan Babat, Provincial Advisor, Abdul Majeed Achakzai, Nasrullah Zere, William Barkat Madam Arfa Siddique MPAs.**

Whereas from 1952 natural gas is supplied from Dera Bugti and Sui was not supplied to any area of this province till 1980, now when it is supplied to Quetta, Kalat, half of district Ziarat and some area of Pishin, unfortunately during the worst cold weather of January when the temperature drops to -13 to -14 C the gas pressure is almost next to none. Ziarat district half area has the natural gas facility whereas the other half does not have it, and where the gas is available the gas burners pressure is not available. All the province and particularly Quetta city people have protested, Sui Gas high ups were called but the problem remains the same.

Same is the situation with electricity. The province daily need is 1600 MWatts and the transmission lines capacity is 600 Mega Watts. Whereas during the previous decade all the natural sources of water, natural springs and karaizes have dried up. Agriculturists have relied on electricity only. Other than that the electricity infrastructure is also next to none. This way the province is neglected regarding electricity and gas. Federal Government's continuous ignorance has been the cause of increase in the people's sense of deprivation.

Hence this House calls on the provincial government to contact federal government as it the responsibility of federal government that they should take immediate notice regarding the electricity and gas issue and on priority basis under a project all the under construction gas and electricity lines' construction and similarly the sanction and initiation and completion of Zhob transmission line and infrastructure work without any delay as well ensuring gas pressure, in order to end prevailing sense of deprivation in the province.

ii. **Resolution No. 16 by Sheikh Jaffer Khan Mandokhail.**

Whereas according to the constitution some districts of Balochistan are included in tribal areas, whose government employees / local contractors are exempted from tax, but still income tax is deducted from them and whereas this incentive has been halted in some districts.

Hence this House calls upon the provincial government to approach federal government so that FBR may reinstate the incentive and issue a notification to end the income tax deduction on employees and contractors.

iii. **Resolution No. 17 by Minister Rehmat Saleh Baloch.**

This house calls upon the provincial government to approach the federal government that the districts which are receiving electricity supply with approval of Iranian government, all these area be supplied

electricity as per Iranian unit cost, and to control the unemployment in these areas permission maybe granted on the use of electricity for agriculture purpose, because due to almost non mentionable source of income desperation has increased in the public, due to economic crunch and unemployment, payment of Iranian electricity on this countries rates is not affordable for the people.

Hence federal government may take practical measures for fulfilling people's long outstanding demand.
