**JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 28 BY AGHA SYED LIQUAT ALI, SARDAR GHULAM MUSTAFA KHAN  
TAREEN, OBAIDULLAH JAN BABAT, REHMAT SALEH BALOCH, MANZOOR AHMED KAKAR AND  
HANDRY MASIH.**

Whereas, Wapda Authorities had unjust fully shut down supply of 94.5 mega watts from Quetta Thermal Power Supply Station in result of wrong policies of some bureaucrats in the last government. Similarly, 300 employees out of 465 employees of Wapda Thermal Power Station were put in surplus pool which not only deprived Balochistan province of a functional thermal power station but also caused losses of billions of rupees to people of Balochistan, the growers and Wapda/PEPCO as well. Moreover, two machines of Quetta Thermal which used to be run on gas and coal and 4500 to 6000 tons of coal had to be used in it, had reached to brink of destruction due to closure of this thermal coal industry of Balochistan, rendering thousands of people working in this industry jobless. As compared to Balochistan the rest of the three provinces of the country have thousands of thermals but Balochistan has become a victim of step motherly attitude.

This House therefore calls upon the provincial government to contact the federal government that like restoration of Lakhra Thermal Power Station of Sindh along with its staff, the remaining three closed units and staff of Quetta Thermal may also be restored, while new units of 200 to 300 mega watts may also be set up to overcome electricity crisis in the province.
