**2 GOVERNMENTAL BUSINESS.**

**i RESOLUTION NO.29 BY Mir.Izhar Hussain Khoso, Mir Abdul Majid Abro,Nawabzada Tariq Magsi, Mir Asim Kurd Galoo,Haji Muhammad Khan Lehri and Rahath Bibi Jamali.**

Whereas in this age of development, any society is indirectly linked to higher education and keeping in view this fact our provincial Govt which is sincere to educational development has put educational up lift of the province on top priority .

However higher educational institutions are spread over in remote and far flung areas of Balochistan depriving a huge majority of its people of higher educational facilities and its best example is Nasirabad Division, Dera Murad Jamali, Jahl Magsi, Usta Muhammad, Dera Allah Yar, Ghandawa , Jafer abad , Bolan and Sobath Poor Distts., which as compare to other divisions is relatively considered to be a prosperous division, but unluckily students of this division are also deprived of higher education facilities.

Keeping in view the contemporary needs of education this house therefore, calls upon theProvincial Govt: to ensure establishment of University campus at Nasirabad in Nasirabad Division.

Besides other problems most of the roads in the city remain log jam due to heavy population burden and huge traffic, especially Sariab road and eastern and western bye passes witness huge rush and traffic jams all the time causing great problems to the people and wastage their precious time.

This house therefore, calls upon the provincial Govt: to take steps for widening of Sariab road and eastern and western bye passes and these should be in PSDP 2014/15 under Quetta package.
