**RESOLUTION NO. 38 BY MOHTARMA SHAHIDA RAUF, MPA.**

Whereas, it is a known fact that Balochistan, area wise is the largest but a backward province of the country and educated youth of this province have always been ignored in federal services. The previous federal government under a package had announced to provide 5000 jobs on federal and 20 thousand jobs on provincial level to end sense of deprivation of youth of Balochistan but at provincial level only 5000 teachers have been appointed while the rest of the vacancies are yet to be filled. Moreover, 4000 vacancies are needed to be filled under Balochistan quota in different departments.

This House therefore calls upon the provincial government to contact the federal government that 4000 vacant posts under Balochistan quota may be announced forthwith and jobless educated youth of the province may be appointed on these posts so the sense of deprivation among them could come to an end.
