Whereas ministry for Religious Affairs this year had sought 40 percent Hajj applications under government quota on the basis of first come first get through the banks from 21st April 2014. However, soon after a day of receipt of Hajj applications it was announced that number of applications of intending pilgrims on government quota was fulfilled while at the same time it was also announced to allot 60 percent quota to the private tour operators. In fact this announcement was aimed at to left the intending pilgrims at the mercy of private tour operators. While in the other Muslim countries as well as in countries where Muslims are in minority lot of facilities are provided with the intending pilgrims including relatively lesser traveling fares, but here Rs. 272000 are being charged for Hajj under government quota while the real expenses are Rs. 257800.

Moreover, Lahore High Court has given a verdict to assign arrangements to the private companies for the intending pilgrims through bidding but despite this all legal and constitutional requirements have been set aside by charging amount twice as compared to government Hajj quota by the private companies which is tantamount to benefit the profiteers through this fifth pillar of Islam.

This house therefore calls upon the provincial government to contact the federal government that steps may be taken to include all the applications of intending pilgrims from Balochistan in the government Hajj scheme, so as sense of deprivation among the Hajj applicants for Hajj 2014 could come to an end.
