to provide for the development, regulation and control of the profession of travel agencies in Balochistan.

Preamble. WHEREAS it is necessary and expedient to provide for the development, regulation and control of the profession of travel agencies in Balochistan and for matters ancillary thereto or connected therewith;
It is hereby enacted as follows:-

Short title, extent and commencement. 1. (1) This Act may be called the Balochistan Travel Agencies Act, 2014.
(2) It extends to the whole of Balochistan, except the Tribal Areas.
(3) It shall come into force at once.

Definitions. 2. In this Act, unless there is any thing repugnant in the subject or context,-

(a) "Act" means the Balochistan Travel Agencies Act 2014;

(b) "Committee" means the Travel Agencies Regulatory Committee setup by the Provincial Government under section 3;

(c) "Government" means the Government of Balochistan;

(d) "Licence" means a licence granted under this Act to any person to operate as a travel agency;

(e) "Licensed guide" means a guide licensed under the law for the regulation and control of the profession of tourist guides;

(f) "Prescribed" means prescribed under the rules;

(g) "rules" means rules made under this Act;

(h) "travel agency" means a person, by whatever name called, who-
