Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Balochistan Civil Servants Act, 1974, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

Short title and commencement.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Balochistan Civil Servants (Amendment) Act, 1989.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of Section 13 of Act IX of 1974.

2. In the Balochistan Civil Servants Act, 1974, after clause (ii) of section 13, the semi colon and the word "or" shall be substituted with a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added, namely:-

"Provided that no civil servant shall be retired under clause (i) and (ii) unless he has been informed in writing of the grounds of the action proposed to be taken against him by the competent authority and has been given reasonable opportunity of showing cause against that action.

EXPLANATION:- In this section "Competent Authority" means the appointing authority of a person duly authorised in that behalf not being a person lower in rank than the Civil Servants concerned".

Repeal.

3. The Balochistan Civil Servants (Amendment) Ordinance, 1989 (X of 1989), is hereby repealed.
