the 10th July, 1974.

No. Legis-X-(5)/74. The West Pakistan Press and Publications (Baluchistan Amendment) Bill, 1974 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Baluchistan on 19th June, 1974 and assented to by the Governor of Baluchistan, is hereby published as an Act of the Provincial Assembly.

THE WEST PAKISTAN PRESS AND PUBLICATIONS (BALUCHISTAN AMENDMENT) ACT, 1974.

BALUCHISTAN ACT NO. VIII OF 1974.

AN ACT

to amend the West Pakistan Press and Publications Ordinance, 1963.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Baluchistan Assembly Members (Salaries and Allowances) Act. 1975 (Baluchistan Act No. II of 1975), for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows -

Short title and commencement.

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Baluchistan Assembly Members (Salaries and Allowances) (Amendment) Act, 1975.
- (2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken place from the 14th day of April, 1975.

Amendment of section 2 of Baluchistan Act No. II of 1975.

- 2. In section 2 of the Baluchistan Members (Salaries and Allowances) Act. 1975 (Baluchistan Act No II of 1975) hereinafter called
  - (1) after clause (f) the following new clause shall be inserted, namely:—
    - "(g) "Secretary" means the Secretary of the Assembly;";
  - (b) existing clauses (g), (h), and (i) shall be re-lettered as clauses
     (h), (i), and (j), respectively.

Insertion of new section 5-A in Baluchistan Act No. II of 1975. 3. In the said Act, after section 5, the following new section shall be inserted, namely:—

"5-A. CONTROLLING OFFICER. The Secretary shall be Controlling Officer for the purpose of travelling allowance admissible under this Act.".

Repeal of Baluchistan Ordinance No. III of 1975.

4. The Baluchistan Assembly Members (Salaries and Allowances) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1975 (Baluchistan Ordinance No. III of 1975) is hereby repealed.
